**No Exhibitor fee will be charged. Gate admission will be charged on arrival at the fairgrounds.**

**Before entering please refer to GENERAL RULES as well as the following:**Additional Rules:

- A. All entries MUST be in place on Fair Day by 9:30 am. Exhibits must remain cooped until 4:00 pm and picked up by 5:00 pm  
 B. Judging will begin at 10:00 AM sharp.  
 C. Closing date for all entries will be two weeks prior to Fair date and must be sent to the Chairperson.  
 D. If exhibiting more than 10 birds, entry money must be received by the Chairperson along with your entry form.  
     **Entries will not be officially accepted until the money has been received. Entry fee is \$.50 per bird. Money will be non-refunded. Chairperson will contact you to confirm your entries have been received.**  
 E. Only 2 entries per section per person with a maximum of 50 birds will be accepted. If after closing date, room is available, the Chairperson will contact exhibitors to allow more entries.  
 F. Any bird showing sickness or disease will be removed immediately.  
 G. No food or water is provided on Fair day.  
 H. Spacing is limited to 150 birds maximum (110 bantam spots available). It will be first come, first served basis
